

## 悼念趙美娟老師

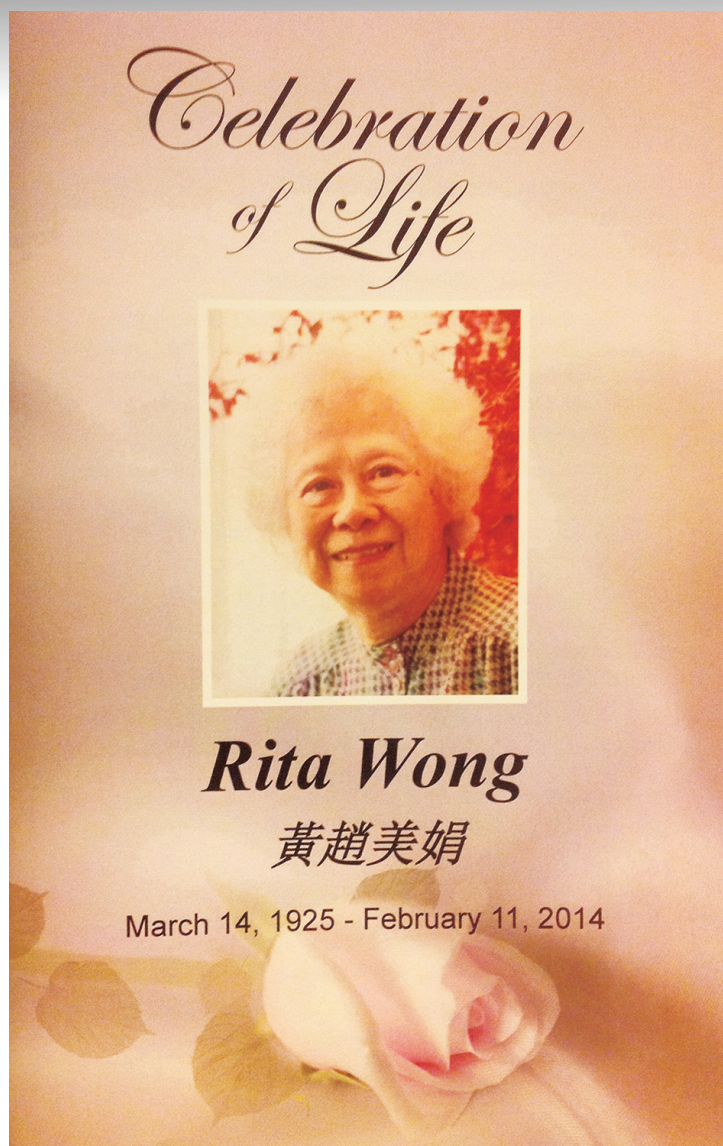
### Notes from former students:
